Nature of Work

- Ability to work independently and bring innovative thinking to a project
- Can take notes and keep jobsite records
- Good jobsite math skills
- Residential/ Commercial finishing experience
- Ability to read plans, layout projects, builds or erects forms and oversees concrete pours.
- Minimum 5 years of demonstrated work experience
- Ability to manage and motivate team members
- Ability to pull a tape on top of a wall and figure overall measurements
- Ability calculate required concrete volume and check for squares
- Ability to look forward to ensure tools and materials are on site as required
- Ensure crew members operate correctly, and take proper care of tools and equipment
- Understand and ensure the proper handling and care of aluminum concrete forms
- Cannot be a last minute thinker
- Valid Drivers License
- Ability to operate equipment
